NOTICE

The **CNLU** (Office Of The Chair Professor, Panchayati Raj, CNLU) & **UNICEF** under the aegis of the Dept. of Panchayati Raj, Govt. of Bihar have come together to provide field level capacity building support on creating a participating led Child Friendly Gram Panchayat model in Bihar.

Forty (40) students (20 for Sherghati block in Gaya district & 20 for Sahdei Buzurg in Vaishali district of Bihar) are required for field capacity building support on creating a participation led Child Gram Panchayat model for the following two purposes :

1. Activating of the standing committees in the 20 GPs in the two blocks of Gaya and Vaishali. Two blocks have been identified for intervention;
2. Engaging with in and out of school adolescents in jointly mapping of issues in their GP and conducting Bal Sabhas to discuss solutions and present them to the Gram Panchayat ahead of the Gram Panchayat Development Programme (GPDP) planning process.

This project would be for 11 months starting from the month of November, 2019.

Students who are willing to provide their services have to visit as per requirements (as decided by the undersigned) during winter internship (November-December) and summer internship (May-June) of our University. When academic session is on in our University then they have to visit for two days in every month in such a way that neither their study will be hampered nor the said programmes will get effected in both the blocks.

For per day visit, UNICEF would pay Rs. 2,500/- (Two Thousand Five Hundred) per student for his/her fooding, lodging & transportation to the assigned block (i.e Sherghati block in Gaya district & Sahdei Buzurg in Vaishali district). CNLU as well as UNICEF will not be responsible for their fooding, lodging & transportation.

Regular students of our University or who have passed from our University who are willing to give their services in the said project are requested to send their Curriculum Vitae (C.V.) indicating their choice of the block latest by 12th October (Saturday), 2019 through **email on profprchaircnlu@gmail.com**

If number of students are more, then a written examination of 100 marks will be taken on 17th October, 2019 at Moot Court Hall, First Floor, Academic Block, CNLU and block will be assigned to them by the State Level Faculty.
